girlfriend recently told me, "I was late to work the other day because I was too busy masturbating." I issued a knowing nod. This kind of thing is commonplace-not only being late someplace because we're getting off, but also talking freely about it among ourselves. Yet, if you believe the limited research that exists on female masturbation, you'd think girls almost never reach below the belt. In a 1992 National Opinion Research Center (NORC) survey, only 54 percent of 3,400 women polled admitted to touching themselves, and 38 percent of those women said they do so no more than three to five times a year.

In my experience, however, those figures are extremely low. The truth is, women masturbate—a lot. In fact, I conducted an informal poll of sexually healthy twenty- and thirtysomethings that blew those NORC results out of the water: Every woman I spoke with confessed to indulging herself regularly, sometimes multiple times a day. Why so often? To answer that question, let's turn to a classic joke. Q:Why does a dog lick his balls? A: Because he can. The

same rings true for women when it comes to self-pleasure—it's quick, easy, and feels awesome. We, too, do it simply because we can.

Just Can't Get Enough

Like you, women try to rub one out whenever we get the chance. But the most convenient time for us is usually first thing in the morning. Chances are, your girl is doing it right under your nose. "When I lived with my boyfriend, I'd actually wait for him to leave for work in the morning," says Ellie*, a 28-yearold photographer. "I just needed to start my day with an orgasm." Debra, a 25-year-old marketing assistant, agrees: "I do it every morning before my shower." For some women, especially those who don't live alone, the shower itself is a sort of sanctuary, providing a few precious minutes of privacy. "My morning shower is one of the few times I have to myself," says Karen, a married 27-year-old student. "I'm naked and soaped up, and the steam from the shower makes the whole experience even hotter. Plus, the showerhead is my tool of choice."

Now don't get paranoid and start thinking your girlfriend is constantly petting her kitty

because you don't satisfy her. "I've had weekends where I've lounged around in bed and done it up to five times in one morning," says Jordan, a 31-year-old advertising exec.

So going it alone isn't something we do *instead* of having sex with you; it's just one aspect of our sex lives. In fact, we sometimes do it *because* of you. "I actually do it more often when I'm in a relationship," says Carolyn, a 32-year-old fashion designer. "I guess the more I'm getting some, the more I want it." The truth is, most women prefer a good, passionate real-life sex session to self-stim any day of the week. Touching ourselves provides that quick orgasm fix we need, but it's no replacement for someone who'll tell us we were good



in bed or give us a kiss after making us shudder with ecstasy. "With my boyfriend sex is a hot bonding experience," explains 27-year-old Sabrina, a musician. It's handy in a pinch, but the real deal will always be infinitely better.

All this talk about coming quickly must have you confused. Yes, we will get angry if you take only three minutes in the sack.
